



## **Recommendation WG3.20.004**

### **Coordination Follow-up Advisories**

**Subject Area:** Notification-Response Procedures

#### **1. Recommendation**

Often, as a result of the coordination process, a successfully completed coordination proposal may be more limited than originally described in the prior coordination notification (PCN). In such cases, a follow-up advisory should be promptly distributed to other affected coordinators so they can suitably adjust their records and provide appropriate coordination protection only for the successfully completed portion of the proposal.

In addition, when a coordinator drops interest in an outstanding PCN or related proposal currently being protected by other coordinators, an appropriate advisory should be promptly distributed to the other affected coordinators. Note that in many cases the six-month rule (FCC Rules Section 101.103 (d) (2) (xi) may be applied by other coordinators to cease protection for a given plan; however, the six-month rule does not apply to all cases and the prompt distribution of follow-up advisories permits other coordinators to maintain more up-to-date and accurate records.
